MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE OF NEW REQUIREMENTS FROM USEF REGARDING PROOF OF VACCINATION

GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule

1. At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinoepneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
2. In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.
3. In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.
4. In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.
5. Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee. **BOD 1/17/15 Effective 12/1/15.**

All horses belonging to one owner must be entered together. No horse may be entered on more than one entry form. The complete name and address of the registered owner must appear in the "Owner" space. One, and only one, owner can appear on each entry form.

Farm name may not be used unless (1) the stable or farm is the bona fide owner on the horse's papers or (2) the stable or farm name has been registered with USEF (see Article 815) and the number shown on the USEF farm certificate is included in the space provided. If a farm name is used as Owner, the farm must have an AHA Business membership and that Business membership number must be used as the Owner AHA number. A copy of the Business membership card must accompany the entry.

If farm/business/trust-owned horses are shown in Amateur-Owner classes, the USEF farm registration certificate showing names of all the owners of the farm must be included with the entry and all owners of the farm must be members of the immediate family.

If an exhibitor is buying the horse on contract, the buyer may be shown as owner on the entry form, a copy of the contract must be submitted with the entry as proof of ownership. Reminder: horses entered in **AO** classes must have registration papers showing the rider/handler or a member of the exhibitor's family as recorded owners of the horse.

Owner, (or agent), trainer and all riders/drivers/handlers/coaches must sign entry form in the spaces provided. If owner is the trainer, owner must sign on both owner and trainer spaces. (Trainer is "any adult who has the responsibility for the care, training, custody or performance of a horse"). Parent or guardian must sign for junior exhibitor in space provided on back of entry form. Complete qualification data (qualifying class name, show name & date, placing, rider/handler, # of horses in class) must be included in "Qualifications" section on front of entry form (or AHA show results form for horse and/or rider included with entry form) for all entries in Regional Championship classes.

ELIGIBILITY TO COMPETE IN AOTR, AAOTR, JOTR CLASSES - Horses entered in amateur owner and junior owner classes must be registered in the name of the competitors or a member of the competitor's family, as defined by USEF GR 122. (Horses registered in a farm/ranch/syndicate/partnership/corporation name may be shown in Amateur Owner classes provided the family is the sole owner of the arm or entity as defined by USEF GR 122.) The sale of a horse does not eliminate this registration requirement. Contracts of Sale or Bill of Sale will not be accepted. Horses must be qualified by an amateur owner.

Horses qualifying for Region 1 Championship classes **FOR THE FIRST TIME AFTER THE April 29 CLOSING DATE** may enter the classes just qualified for without penalty until May 17, any classes entered other than the just-qualified Regional class will be subject to the double class fee post entry penalty. After May 17, **DOUBLE** class fee post entry penalties will apply for all classes **EXCEPT** entries qualifying for the **FIRST** time for a championship class at the Pre-Show will be accepted without penalty until 5:00 pm on the day preceding the class to be entered. Any entry which is shown in a class in which it was not properly entered will be charged **TRIPLE** the class entry fee. To be properly entered, the class must have been listed on the original entry form or on a properly submitted **ADD-A-CLASS** form in the horse show office prior to the class in question. STABLE INFORMATION

STABLING

Permanent box stalls with doors will be available at a fee of \$160 each (NO BEDDING PROVIDED) No straw is allowed on the grounds. Grooming stalls and tack rooms are available at a fee of \$160 each. Tack rooms may have concrete floors and/or regular entry doors. Each animal must be assigned to a separate stall (exception: broodmares with suckling foals) unless no stall is requested, in which case a trailer-in fee of \$35.00 per horse per day shall be charged. Removal of stall, groom or tack room doors will incur a \$100 per stall charge plus damages. Any decorating material (bark, flowers, sod, framing etc.) must be removed or owner/trainer will be charged additional fee for removal. The minimum charge imposed by the fairgrounds is \$100. **ANY EARLY ARRIVALS MUST BE APPROVED BY DEL MAR AND THE SHOW MANAGER.**

FEED AND BEDDING

All feed and bedding orders must be placed with the Del Mar Feed Store at the Fairgrounds. Call (858) 509-5245 to pre-order additional bedding or feed. Payment must be made directly to the Del Mar Feed Store.

Exhibitors wishing to be stabled together must submit their entries together in the same envelope. If you have any special stabling requests or considerations, submit them on a separate sheet with the entry. There will be a charge of \$75/day for the use of any stall or tack room by anyone other than the exhibitor assigned to same. Assignment of stalls is entirely at the discretion of show management. Horses must be placed in stalls assigned and no changes will be permitted without the express consent of the Barn Manager. Exhibitors must notify the barn manager of any changes in stabling. Every horse in a stall **MUST** be entered in the show.

REGIONAL SHOW SCORING AND PLACING

Top Five Awards will be given regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed five awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes payout, AHA horse achievement awards, amateur achievement awards, high point horse achievement awards, high point amateur achievement awards.

STABLE ASSIGNMENT POLICY

Barn assignments are subject to annual review of the Show Commission. The Show Commission has ultimate discretion in determination of barn assignments. Some of the criteria used to determine barn assignments are number of years of participation, degree of support and number of horses. Region One has adopted a barn assignment policy that favors those farms and/or exhibitors who have maintained a high level of support. Exhibitors requesting specific barn locations please note the following:

Patrons will have preference in assignment of barn fronts (must be paid in advance)

STABLE AVAILABILITY

Stalls will be available noon Monday May 11, 2020, and must be vacated no later than noon, Monday, May 18, 2020. Contact Show Manager Phil Bourgeois (619) 993-4169 if you have any questions. **ANY EARLY ARRIVALS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE SHOW MANAGER.**

TRUCK AND TRAILER ENTRANCE

Exhibitors may enter through the Stable Gate on Jimmy Durante Blvd just off of Via de la Valle from noon to 9 pm on Monday, May 13th & May 17th and from 6 am to 9 pm on Tuesday May 12th and Sunday May 17th. Any other times exhibitors must use the Solana Beach Gate on Via de la Valle near the northwest corner of the Fairgrounds. The barn Office will be located in the bungalow at the northeast corner of the stable area.

TRAILER PARKING AREAS - Specific areas have been set aside for parking of horse trailers and vans of exhibitors reserving stalls. Special parking areas will be available for exhibitors showing from trailers. Motor-bikes and motorcycles are prohibited on the fairgrounds. Because parking is limited in the barn area, exhibitors will be issued a limited number of parking permits for the stable area. Overflow exhibitor vehicles may be parked in the paved parking lot on the south side of the horse show arena (2nd gate off Jimmy Durante Blvd.) Fire regulations prohibit parking between the barns.

RV SPACE RESERVATIONS

All reservations and payment for RV or Motorhome spaces must be made directly with Del Mar Fairgrounds. Call (858) 509-5245 for rates and reservations. **DO NOT INCLUDE RV SPACE REQUESTS OR PAYMENT WITH YOUR ENTRIES.**

ADMISSION TO THE RING - No person will be permitted to enter the ring except participants in the class, judges, their assistants and show officials. Attendants and grooms may enter the ring only when summoned by order of the judge. In all cases requiring attendants in the ring, proper attire is required.

AHA MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT - Each competitor (this includes at least one recorded owner and all trainers, drivers, riders, halter handlers, coaches and the person(s) signing the entry blank) in an Arabian Horse Association recognized Arabian Division, at the time of entry into a competition, must submit a copy of a valid AHA membership/competition card. Join AHA or pay an AHA single event membership fee per competitor. When an agent signs for the owner at an AHA recognized competition, both the owner and agent must be members of AHA or pay the AHA single event membership. Single event membership is not acceptable at AHA Regional or National competitions. Exhibitors in walk/trot classes are exempt from AHA membership requirements at qualifying competitions, but must have an AHA membership with a competition card at AHA Regional and National competitions. Exhibitors in lead line classes or parents/guardians signing for minors are exempt from AHA membership requirements. (BOD 5/12).

AMATEUR - AMATEUR CERTIFICATION - Only active Federation members may obtain amateur status. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under Federation rules must possess current amateur status issued by the Federation. (Exception: This is not required for Opportunity classes). This status must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the competition secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such status provided by the Federation. Amateur status will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Foreign riders requesting Federation Amateur status, must be a Junior, Senior or Life Competing Member of the Federation (Exception: Equine Canada members in possession of current EC membership may sign for USEF Amateur status on a show by show basis at no cost). Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status. 2. An amateur continues to be such until he/she has received a change in status from the Federation. Any amateur who wishes to be re-classified on the grounds that he/she has engaged or is planning on engaging in activities which would prevent him/her from continuing to remain an amateur must notify the Federation in writing. 3. There is no fee for amateur status for Senior Active or Life Members. Such status will expire on November 30th.

ARENA DIMENSIONS AND FOOTING - The Grandstand (Del Mar) arena is 317' x 153'; the San Diego arena (nearest to the first turn of the race track) and the Jimmy Durante Arena (to the East of the San Diego arena) are both 250' x 125'. All arenas have sand, shavings and dirt for footing. In addition the chute for the back stretch furlong is used for warm-up has the same footing as the arenas.

CANCELLATION OF ENTRY

To encourage early entries, the Management agrees to cancel and refund entry, stall and all fees on any horse not fit to show providing written or email notification regiononeshowsecretary@gmail.com is given to the Show Secretary on or before entry closing date. Exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason after the official entry closing date shall forfeit all fees, except if a horse is scratched prior to May 16 by written communication to the show secretary, stall fees minus a \$25 handling fee will be refunded and tack/groom room fees will be refunded. No substitution of horses will be permitted except as provided in USEF Article 1506.2. Absolutely no requests for refunds for ANY reasons will be considered unless such written request with supporting documentation is in the show secretary's hand PRIOR to the show. No exhibitor may withdraw horses from the show after it has commenced, or remove them from the grounds, without the permission of the show manager.

CLASS CALLS - Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to be sure that his horse is at the gate at it's prescribed time. Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system to carry class calls; however, no protest will be upheld, nor will any class be changed on the basis of PA malfunction alone.

DISCIPLINE - Exhibitors are warned that any act of discourtesy to the officials of this show on the part of the owner, lessee, trainer, groom, rider, or driver will disqualify the horse from adjudication. The management reserves the right to remove a horse owner, lessee, trainer, groom or rider from the show without being liable for compensation or damages.

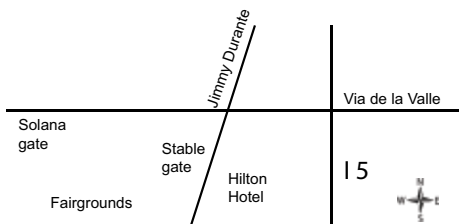
DISQUALIFICATION - Any horse doctored in any way, artificially, improperly, or unfairly prepared or tampered with before entering the show arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that any exhibitor has made, or caused to be made a false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited, or if any exhibitor shall attempt to interfere with the judges in the performance of their duties, he or she shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting.

DOGS - The State Humane Officer requires dogs to be confined or on a leash at all times and are not allowed outside the barn area. Dogs are NOT ALLOWED in the grandstand or show office area at any time.

DRUGS AND MEDICATIONS - The State of California and USEF requires that both halter and performance horses entering any show offering prize money will be charged a USEF drug testing fee of \$15.00 and a California drug testing fee of \$5 to help defray the expense of testing. USEF and California rules regarding drugs and medications will be enforced. In addition, an \$8 USEF fee must be charged for each horse entered.

DIRECTIONS - Directions: The Del Mar Fairgrounds is located 20 miles north of downtown San Diego, at 2260 Jimmy Durante Blvd. in the city of Del Mar, California. From Interstate 5, take the Via de la Valle exit and head west (a left turn from the freeway exit if you are northbound; a right turn if you are southbound). Take Via De La Valle to Jimmy Durante Boulevard and turn left. Follow signs and the instructions of parking personnel to Fair parking.



HEADERS - In all classes requiring grooms or other assistants, proper attire is required.

FAILURE TO CANCEL CLASSES OR COMPLETE RIDER CHANGE FORMS - A rider change form must be completed in the show office before the start of the session for any change from rider/handler listed on the entry. All riders/handlers and their member numbers must be reported to AHA for qualification and awards tracking. Exhibitors are required to complete an official scratch form prior to the class for all scratches. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to advise the show office of rider changes or scratches prior to a class; failure to complete rider change or scratch forms prior to the class will result in a \$25 fine and that horse, owner and rider-handler may not show in subsequent classes until the fine is paid at the show office. This courtesy will enable gatemens and the office to function efficiently.

FARRIER AND VETERINARIAN - A qualified farrier will be available on the grounds, Wednesday May 13 and thereafter throughout the show. An exhibitor may arrange an appointment with the farrier on Tuesday May 12 by contacting him directly, as early as possible. Management will employ a California licensed equine veterinarian as the official show veterinarian. Show management reserves the right to refuse entry onto the show grounds to any horse exposed to, or which may be harboring a communicable disease. All animals are subject to a physical inspection by the Official Show Veterinarian.

GOLF CARTS - A limited number of golf carts will be available for rent during the show week. Call Nancy Harvey (626) 355-9101 or email Nancy at regiononeshowsecretary@gmail.com. First come first served.

HOSPITALITY ROOM - A hospitality room in the barn area will be serving coffee and donuts from 6:00 am to 7:30 am on show days for exhibitor's enjoyment.

IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS - Every horse entered in the show will be assigned a separate identification number. It is important for the proper handling of the show that the correct number be worn by the rider or handler in all classes.

INDEMNITY AND NON-RESPONSIBILITY CLAUSES

All entries are accepted with the understanding that the Region One Arabian Horse Association, Region 1 AHA and 22nd Agricultural District not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned by him, his agents or employees, or by an animal owned or exhibited, and shall indemnify the Region 1 of AHA, AHA and 22nd Agricultural District against any and all loss, damages and liability thus occasioned, including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form to the Show Secretary shall constitute an acceptance by each person signing same of the provisions herein set forth.

JUDGES - If for any reason a judge fails to attend this show or perform his/her duties, the Show Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge for the one who is officially designated in the Prize List. It is a violation of USEF Rules to commit any act or make remarks during the show that are considered offensive and/or made with the intent to influence or cast aspersions on the judging. No one shall approach a judge with regard to a decision or at any time unless he first obtains permission from the Show Steward who shall arrange an appointment with the judge at a proper time and place.

LOCATION OF CLASSES - Show management reserves the right to hold classes, or portions of classes, on the grounds outside the Main Arena if it is found necessary to do so, or to change and/or modify the Schedule of Events as necessary to accommodate the entries received.

MISSING NUMBER OR NO NUMBER - There will be a \$25 fee for missing or non numbers.

PRIZE MONEY - All Sweepstakes prize money will be distributed by the AHA office at the end of the year.

Paddock Area Conduct - There shall be no conduct in the paddock area which disturbs or creates a hazard to horses or handlers. There will be no whips, noise-makers or other equipment, devices, or objects allowed in the paddock area which might disturb or create a hazard to horses or handlers in the area, except the show whip properly carried by a handler in the paddock area.

Protests - Should any questions or disputes arise, they must be protested in the manner prescribed by USEF Chapter 6.

Qualification Reminder - Previous Regional Championships, Regional Reserve Championships or Top Five awards are no longer qualifying wins for Regional Championship classes. Only points, scores or qualifying placings won at Region One qualifying shows within the past calendar year or prior to the Regional championship show in this year can be used as qualification for this Regional Championship show.

Qualification Requirements - Horses entered in regional championship classes must be qualified in a show that was held within the preceding calendar year and that period of the current year up to the commencement of the Regional Championship show. See AHA Handbook for qualification requirements. Horses entered in JTR or ATR classes must have been qualified by an amateur or junior. Horses entered in AAOTR, JO or AO classes must have been qualified by an Amateur Owner. It is the responsibility of the amateur and/or owner to abide by these rules.

Refusal of Entries - The management reserves the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or cancel any entries of any exhibitors, as stated in USEF GR1509.

Region One Championship Judging System - All Regional Championship Shows are required to use the AHA approved Majority Opinion System (MOS) scoring program in all applicable breeding/in-hand halter, performance and equitation classes. Regional Championship Dressage, Sport Horse, Trail, Reining and Reining Seat equitation classes will utilize a single judge system. In Reining and Trail horse classes, the score given by the judge will be announced prior to the work of the subsequent horses. Ties for Champion, Reserve Champion and fifth in a Top Five will be worked off using the same pattern, order of go and scoring techniques as was used in the class. If a tie still persists, the judge will be requested to rank the tied horses without further work-offs. In the case of a tie in a Dressage class, the judge shall determine the winner.

Regional Show Scoring and Placing - Top Five Awards will be given regardless of the number of entries in a class. However, only awards made to the top 50% of the class (rounded up and not to exceed five awards) will receive Arabian Breeders Sweepstakes pay out, AHA horse achievement awards, amateur achievement awards, high point horse achievement awards, high point amateur achievement awards.

Regional Championship Entry Qualifications - It is the responsibility of the person(s) signing the entry form to verify that the horse is eligible to be entered and compete in the Regional Championship class. No refunds will be made for horses improperly entered in Regional Championship or Sweepstakes classes. Exhibitors entering Regional Championship classes must include a copy of the horse's competition record from AHA or complete the qualification section on the front of the entry form. Qualifying data must be complete - including show name and date, qualifying class name, placing in the class, name of rider in qualifying class for ATR, JTR, AAOTR, JOTR, AOTR classes, and number of horses in the qualifying class.

Registration Requirements - Horses shown in this division must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association Inc., and/or the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for and must be entered under their full registered name. (Only weanlings that have had registration applied for may show without registration papers).

Horses shown in the HA/AA section must have been issued a certificate of registration from the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) in the Half-Arabian or Anglo-Arabian Registry, or have been issued an AHA (Canadian Partbred Arabian Register). Certificate of Registration issued by the Canadian Partbred Register, or if under one year of age, be eligible for registry and registration applied for, and must be entered under their full registered name.

A legible copy of the entire registration papers showing proof of ownership for each horse entered in the show must be submitted with the entry form. In the case of a contract of sale or lease, it is required that a copy of the sale contract or lease (containing registered name and number of the horse, date and signature of the seller or lessor) be submitted with a copy of the registration papers.

Ring Procedure - Towels, Whips & Other Objects. Once an animal is being exhibited in the show ring, there will be no objects of any nature, e.g., towels, whips, treats, etc., passed or transferred from a person on the rail to any exhibitor inside the show ring.

Trail Fee - A equipment fee of \$25 is required for all Trail participants. **The trail obstacles will remain up for schooling and trail participants who have paid this fee will have access to the trail courses throughout the show.**

TWO MINUTE RULE - Due to a full schedule of classes the TWO-MINUTE limit after last call for a class will be strictly enforced. Exhibitors are cautioned against entering the same horse in successive classes. The gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring or in cases with large classes taking more than 2 minutes at the completion of final horse in the continuous string of horses. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR TO BE SURE THAT HIS/HER HORSE IS AT THE GATE ON TIME. CLASS CALLS MUST BE CONSIDERED A COURTESY ONLY. No protests will be upheld on the basis of a public address system malfunction. "Open" cards may be run for Trail/ classes to assist exhibitors who might have a conflict with classes in another arena. Check with show manager or in the show office for details.

TBA - Region 1 has allotted space for TBA classes in the Pre-Show and TBA classes in the Regional Show. TBA classes may be any class on the AHA class list or that is recognized by AHA with the exception of dressage, cutting, reined cow, hunter/jumper. These classes may be placed throughout the schedule. Pre-show TBA Fee is \$100/class plus the class entry fee. Regional TBA Fee is \$200/class plus class entry. If TBA classes have 5 or more entries the TBA fee will be refunded to the requestor. TBAs are given on a first come first served basis only and must be reserved by May 13, 2020 with the show secretary. TBAs cannot be age split classes.

RULES

This Horse Show is conducted in accordance with the rules of the US Equestrian Federation (National Equestrian Federation of the United States), Chapter AR - Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian Division. The official Rule Book of US Equestrian will prevail for this show. This Prize List is based on rules of the current Rule Book; any changes or corrections of rules will automatically become a part of the Prize List. Each participant in this show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the USEF Rules.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Questions not covered by USEF Rules shall be decided by the Show Committee and its decision will be final.

USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

USEF AMATEUR CERTIFICATION FOR EC AMATEUR MEMBERS - EC amateur members, competing in amateur classes, must complete and sign a USEF membership application verifying they meet USEF amateur requirements. There is no charge.

NEW AMATEUR/OWNER RULE - COMBINED OWNERSHIP IS PERMITTED IN OWNER'S OR AMATEUR OWNER'S CLASSES. PLEASE SEE THE USEF RULE BOOK RULE — AR110.4.e

USEF MEMBERSHIP - Affidavits are no longer accepted for payment of non-member fees. Exhibitors must have a Competing Membership, either Life, Senior Active or Junior Active Member or pay a Show Pass Fee. See next paragraph.

USEF NON-MEMBER PARTICIPATION - If membership documentation is not submitted to the competition and the competition cannot verify such information, the exhibitor will be required to complete a Show Pass form and pay a non-refundable Show Pass fee of \$45.00. (GR1309.2.b) Purchase of a Show Pass fee does NOT allow a competitor to show in amateur classes. To show in an amateur class, a competitor must provide proof of membership with amateur certification.

USDF Statement on Animal Welfare

The United States Dressage Federation, Inc. (USDF), a federation of over 100 independent organizations throughout the United States with a membership of nearly 30,000 members, supports the concept of ethical treatment of animals.

Dressage is a classical method of training horses, based upon the horse's natural responses, as carried out in a gradual, planned program during which the horse's athletic abilities are improved in a systematic manner. As a result, the horse becomes capable, comfortable, and responsive in partnership with the rider without the use of force. Dressage competition at various levels of achievement is the ultimate test of the training program to determine whether the desired harmony between horse and rider has been achieved.

The rules pertaining to dressage competition prohibit the use of artificial appliances, training aids, and drugs, which would force the horse to submit. Instead, the emphasis is upon training and a cooperative partnership with the rider. Major competitions are carefully monitored to assure that there is no unnecessary force or harshness displayed.

Unlike other horse sports in which horses enter training at a relatively immature state, dressage training is usually not seriously begun until the horse is three or four. The top levels of achievement require five or more years of progressive training and it is not unusual to see horses in international competition in their late teens. This, in itself, places a premium on good care and soundness throughout the horse's life.

While supporting the concept of animal welfare in its broadest form, the United States Dressage Federation, Inc., also recognizes that it is unrealistic to ascribe human emotions and responses to the horse which in its wild state is a creature of flight, living a hard and precarious existence. Under domestication, the horse is assured of ample food, water, and shelter, as well as protection against infectious diseases and damaging parasites, thus leading a longer and healthier life with a high rate of survival.

As an educational organization, USDF has numerous programs, which teach people how to pursue the accepted, humane training methods. A program of certifying instructors also emphasizes protecting the horse's welfare in pursuit of dressage training.

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (GM), Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses ridden in headline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$90), 5-years (\$360), or life (\$1,800). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$72). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$240) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Education Membership (EM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. This online education only membership expires 12 months after the date joined. This membership type does NOT allow an individual to compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$35 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number requirements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post-competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$35). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$80. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$115) is eligible for Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form and fax or mail it to the USDF office.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.

Dressage

All dressage classes are open to Arabian, Half-Arabian and Anglo-Arabian horses.

2019 tests will be ridden. Riders will be notified of their ride times prior to the show.

Please Note - Dressage classes may not be run in class order

AHA ENTRY AGREEMENT

I have read the rules concerning competitions as printed in the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) Handbook / Directory and Competition Prize List and agree to be bound by and subject to those Rules.

AHA ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE AND INDEMNIFICATION This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

In consideration for AHA permitting me to participate in this Competition, and by signing the entry blank, I agree as follows:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in this Competition, as a rider, driver, handler, lessee, owner, agent, coach, trainer, junior exhibitor, or as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. **I AM FULLY AWARE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSE SPORTS AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS COMPETITION INVOLVE SERIOUS RISK OF HARM INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, RISKS OF ACCIDENT, SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING DEATH, BROKEN BONES, HEAD INJURIES, TRAUMA, PAIN, AND SUFFERING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. I ASSUME ALL RISKS OF HARM TO ME, MY HORSE OR MY PROPERTY.**

I AGREE for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns to release AHA, the Competition, the facilities leased by the Competition and the owner(s) of the facilities, and all of their respective officers, officials, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, affiliated organizations and insurers (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all claims for damage, loss, or injury to myself, other persons, horses or other property belonging to me to the fullest extent permitted by law that arises out of or relates in any way to the Competition and my participation in the Competition INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DAMAGES, LOSS, OR INJURY RESULTING FROM ANY ACTS, FAILURE TO ACT, NEGLIGENCE OR NEGLECT OF OTHER ENTRANTS, THE RELEASED PARTIES, THEIR CONTRACTORS OR INVITEES, as well as for theft, vandalism, fire, other casualty damage, or damage arising out of any defects in the premises.

I AGREE to accept AS FINAL any decision of AHA, the Show Commission or Show Officials concerning my qualification or the qualification of my horse to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition, except to the extent that the Rules of AHA, the Competition, CEF or USA Equestrian permit a protest or hearing of such decisions. Should a hearing be requested, I agree to accept AS FINAL the decision of the particular hearing body. I agree to release, hold harmless and not to sue AHA, the Competition Sponsor, their officers, directors, employees, volunteers or members concerning any decision of AHA, the Competition, its Show Commission, Show Officials or any hearing body that relates to my qualifications or my horse(s)' qualifications to enter the Competition or any results of the Competition.

I AGREE that AHA has the sole right to control, sell, supervise or give away (or assign to others the right to do so) the exclusive rights to broadcast, televise, reproduce, transmit and disseminate all or part of this event, and I agree that AHA may use or assign, in any way AHA sees fit, photographs, films, videos, audios, cablecasts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition or AHA. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way which implies endorsement of any company, product, product category or service. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation.

By signing below as a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and agree to all of the above provisions, and further agree to assume all of the obligations of this AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification personally and on behalf of the child.

This AHA Assumption of Risk, Release and Indemnification is governed by the Laws of the State of Colorado and is intended to be interpreted as broadly as possible. I agree that exclusive jurisdiction and venue (place) for any legal action against AHA, its officers, directors, employees, volunteers or agents shall be in the local district courts or the federal court of the State of Colorado. If any part of this agreement is determined to be unenforceable, all other parts shall remain effect.

Federation entry agreement

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaultor or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc.
