





JUST FOR FUN



HOLIDAY HORSE COOKIES

READY IN: 1hr 10mins

YIELD: 36 horse treats

INGREDIENTS:

4 cups steam rolled oats

- 8 tablespoons flour
- ¹/₂ cup molasses
- ³/₄ cup water

DIRECTIONS:

- Combine all ingredients in large mixing bowl.
- Stir with large spoon until mixture is the consistency of thick cookie dough.
- Drop tablespoons of dough on a greased cookie sheet, spacing cookies 1 inch apart.
- Bake at 300 degrees for 1 hour or until crisp.
- Remove from oven and cool for 30 minutes.
